

SITUATION: (A1) Due to recent flooding, 30 head of beef cattle are stranded on a levee. The cattle will require feed until the water recedes in approximately 5 days.

NEEDS:

- Watercraft to transport hay
- Approximately 4,500 pounds of hay

SITUATION: (A2) Due to recent flooding, 30 feeder calves (400-600 lbs. each) were swept away and drowned. Local responders request assistance moving the carcasses from the public riverbank until they can be transported to the landfill.

NEEDS:

- Tarps and containment materials to secure carcasses awaiting transport
- Equipment and operators to move carcasses from the riverbank

SITUATION: (A3) Approximately 50 deceased feeder calves (400-600 lbs. each) were removed from the river after flooding. Local responders request transportation of the carcasses to the landfill.

NEEDS:

- Transportation with containment capabilities to limit liquid, solid, and airborne emissions during transport
- Driver with a CDL license

SITUATION: (A4) Downed fences from recent storms have caused approximately 40 head of beef cattle to wander onto the interstate creating a hazard for motorists.

NEEDS:

- Supplies and equipment to capture and contain cattle
- At least 8 personnel with cattle handling experience to assist in containment

SITUATION: (A5) An active cattle show facility is being repurposed to shelter displaced people. 20 beef cattle need to be contained elsewhere for 72-hours until the owners can retrieve them.

NEEDS:

- Cattle feed to sustain cattle during the containment period
- Potable water for cattle
- Security personnel to oversee cattle

SITUATION: (A6) A semi-tractor trailer overturned on the interstate trapping 10 cattle. 40 additional head of cattle are loose on the road. First responders are requesting euthanasia for downed livestock and aid in capturing loose cattle.

NEEDS:

- Authorized personnel for euthanasia
- Qualified personnel and related supplies to capture livestock

SITUATION: (A7) Straight-line winds caused a portion of the public fairground barn to collapse and kill 50 head of cattle. Fairground management requests assistance with carcass removal.

NEEDS:

- Equipment for carcass removal
- Transportation with containment capabilities to limit liquid, solid, and airborne emissions during transport
- 2 equipment operators

SITUATION: (A8) Local beef farmers report catastrophic damages to fences after a tornado. News reports indicate a need for fencing supplies and erroneously direct donations to the county fire stations. Unsolicited donated supplies are blocking fire apparatuses.

NEEDS:

- Donations management site with water and electricity
- Vehicle to move donations from fire stations to new site
- 6 staff to manage distribution center

SITUATION: (A9) 100 head of beef cattle are stranded in 2-3 feet of floodwater and need to be relocated to higher ground.

NEEDS:

- At least 6 personnel trained in water rescue
- 1 cattle handling subject matter expert
- Watercraft to herd the cattle to higher ground

SITUATION: (A10) A semi-tractor trailer overturned on the interstate. 40 head of beef cattle are loose. Responders need assistance with transportation and relocation of the cattle.

NEEDS:

- Transportation for moving cattle
- Temporary holding facility suitable for relocated cattle

SITUATION: (A11) Farmers struggle to provide adequate feed for cattle after a natural disaster. Elementary school students post a need for animal feed on social media. Feed donations are pouring in at the local public schools.

NEEDS:

- Inventory system to document donations
- Media liaison

SITUATION: (A12) A natural disaster damaged 2,000 feet of livestock fencing. Crews need to repair it quickly to contain cattle.

NEEDS:

- 5 people to repair fences
- Truck and trailer to haul fencing supplies
- Fencing supplies

SITUATION: (A13) A livestock barn at the fairgrounds is designated for human sheltering. The facility needs to be cleaned and disinfected.

NEEDS:

- 6 personnel with just-in-time training
- Cleaning and disinfecting supplies
- Heavy equipment to move manure

SITUATION: (A14) Loose cattle were discovered after a storm. The cattle must be collected and transported to a holding location until owners can legally reclaim them.

NEEDS:

- 10 personnel with livestock experience for cattle identification and documentation
- Driver(s), truck(s), and trailer(s) to transport cattle to holding site

SITUATION: (A15) During a controlled burn, the fire spread beyond the intended area and caused 30 cattle to bolt through a fence onto a public roadway.

NEEDS:

- 5 personnel with animal health experience to triage the cattle
- Temporary holding facility
- Drinking water for cattle

SITUATION: (A16) 5 steers were brought to a college campus for an educational seminar. Someone forgot to close the gate, and the steers roam the city streets. First responders require assistance catching the cattle before bystanders are injured.

NEEDS:

- 10 personnel with cattle-handling experience
- Shovels and buckets for manure management on public streets

SITUATION: (A17) Recent rain caused significant mudslides trapping 12 show cattle at the county fairgrounds. Fair workers require assistance creating an egress point for the cattle.

NEEDS:

- Equipment for mud removal from roads and barn area
- Personnel for mud removal from roads and barn area
- Personal protective equipment for potential hazards in the mud

SITUATION: (A18) A bull escaped from the local stockyard, fell into a sinkhole in the public park, and broke his femur. The owner grants permission to euthanize the bull. The commotion attracts people attending a nearby wedding.

NEEDS:

- 1 person authorized for humane euthanasia
- 3 people for crowd control
- A wedding gift for the happy couple

SITUATION: (A19) A park ranger discovers a dead calf in an abandoned well. The well connects to an aquifer used for the public drinking water supply. The carcass needs to be removed.

NEEDS:

- Equipment to remove the calf from the well
- Personnel to operate equipment to remove the calf from the well
- 1 media liaison to communicate a boil water advisory

SITUATION: (A20) Lightning strikes the county fairgrounds, setting a barn on fire and killing 10 head of cattle. Due to local regulations, the carcasses must be composted off-site.

NEEDS:

- Personnel with composting knowledge
- Vehicle appropriate for moving carcasses offsite
- Composting materials (hay, paper, shavings, etc.)
